The Board of Public Works & Safety of the City of Huntingburg met in regular session on Thursday, May 2, 2024 at the hour of 8:30 A.M. in the Council Chambers of the Huntingburg City Hall. 
Police Chief Parks presented the monthly police report. He updated the Board on the firing range and noted that he will have a list of donors to the firing range at the next meeting.


Planning Director Lake presented his monthly reports.
